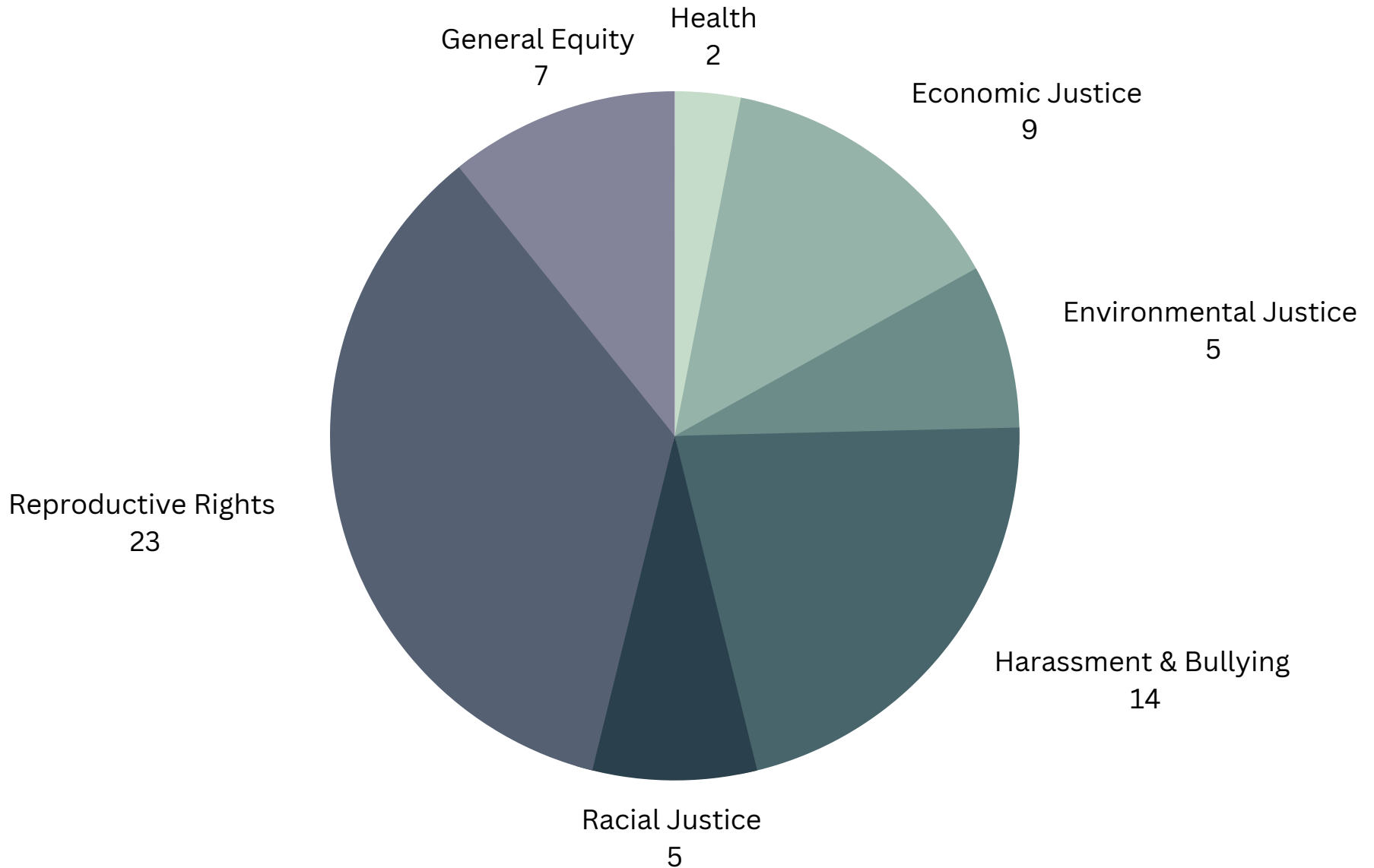




# VERMONT WORKS FOR WOMEN
