Vermont Parent Representation Center's <u>Bending the Curve to Improve Our Child</u> <u>Protection System Report</u> was presented at the March 2019 VCW meeting, as well as representatives from DCF and Legislative Working Group. Karen Vastine of DCF & Judge Grearson.

The Committee should come up with a proposal and Kellie should bring it forward as a motion. The key points to include are:

- The topic is large and we have limited staff capacity
- People already working on this issue with more expertise
- The Education and Human Development Committee will keep apprised of what's happening and follow-up in the future – no later than the end of 2019 and report back to VCW.
- The Commission should not dedicate a lot of time to this topic.
