Adopted September 9, 2022

- Be aware of our own body language and use it to communicate respect
- Acknowledge and take into consideration those perspectives that are not represented by people in the room
- Take responsibility for the impact of our words and actions on each other
- Sring self-awareness of our own state of mind, emotions, and influences
- Remember that we come to the space with differing understandings of how we communicate
- Understand we all make mistakes
- Be patient with ourselves and others
- Share the job of holding each other accountable to these agreements
